First Order of Business:

Upon the motion of Past Commander-in-Chief Kelly Barrow and the second of Adjutant-in-Chief Doug Nash, Jr. to place the Marra soldiers' statue at the end of the front driveway of Elm Springs the GEC voted to not approve the placement at this time.

Second Order of Business:

Upon the motion of Past Commander-in-Chief Thomas V. Strain, Jr. and the second of Judge Advocate-in-Chief Scott Hall the GEC voted, with objection, to place the President Jefferson Davis statue outside the staff breakroom/patio area (site A).

Third Order of Business:

Upon the motion of Adjutant-in-Chief Doug Nash, Jr. and the second of Chaplain-in-Chief Dr. Herman White the GEC voted, without objection, to grant approval for the Stephen Mallory Camp 1315, Pensacola, Florida, via pro-bono donation by two (2) SCV member attorneys Andy Strickland and David McCallister, to contest, under existing Florida State grave protection laws, to restore the proper flag, maintenance and memorial observances at the Mallory plot at historic St. Michaels Cemetery.
