Commander-in-Chief Larry McCluney, Jr. stated the purpose of the teleconference was to deal with two pieces of business.

The first order of business is the Tennessee Division is asking for permission from the General Executive Council to proceed with filing a complaint with the Tennessee Historical Commission against Williamson County's desire to remove the Confederate Battle Flag from the County Seal.

AOT Councilman Carl Jones made a motion that the General Executive Council approves the Tennessee Division's request. Motion seconded by Past Commander-in-Chief Paul Gramling. The motion passed.

The second order of business, Commander-in-Chief Larry McCluney, Jr. gave the floor to Lt. Commander-in-Chief Jason Boshers. Lt. Commander-in-Chief Jason Boshers laid out the proposal to hold an annual Pilgrimage to Elm Springs in honor of Confederate Memorial Day on May 1, 2021. The estimated cost of the event will be \$1,355. Lt. Commander-in-Chief Jason Boshers informed the General Executive Council that a husband and wife will donated their \$600 Stimulus Checks to help pay for the event and Jason said he would make up the difference which would mean no cost to the Confederation. Chaplain-in-Chief Herman White made a motion to accept the donations and proceed with the Pilgrimage to Elm Springs Event as presented. Judge Advocate-in-Chief Scott Hall seconded the motion. After more discussion concerning the date, the motion passed with a vote of 12 yeas and 2 nos.

On Monday night, January 4, 2021, the Tennessee Division Executive Council held an emergency executive session Zoom. The subject of the meeting was concerning the recent actions in Franklin, specifically the Williamson County Seal. Williamson County has filled for a waiver with the Tennessee Historical Commission to have the Confederate Battle Flag removed from the county seal.

Compatriot James Turner, who has been kept a close eye on the situation, asked the Tennessee DEC for permission to file a complaint with the Tennessee Historical Commission. The Tennessee DEC voted to proceed with the complaint, with funding up to \$7,000.00.

With this notification, the Tennessee Division is asking for permission from the Sons of Confederate Veterans GEC to proceed with this. I will be await your response.

**Pilgrimage to Elm Springs
May 1, 2021**

Budget Estimate

The Pilgrimage to Elm Springs will occur from 9 AM to 4 PM on Saturday May 1, 2021.

A determination of need brought forth 3 items based off the number of estimate attendance of 1,000 to 2,500 individuals and the need for social distancing.

- 1) Port-a-johns; even though the house has restrooms and the museum has restrooms; having an estimate of this number of visitors at once would cause an over run and people could not spread out. With an estimate attendance of 1,000 to 2,500, a total of four (4) port-a-johns are needed. The break down is two (2) regular at \$85 each and two (2) handicap accessible at \$130 each. Royal Flush is the provider of the port-a-johns.

$$2 \times \$85 = \$170$$

$$2 \times \$130 = \$260$$

$$\text{Total for port-a-johns} = \$430$$

- 2) Security: Using the number of people estimated to be present; Platinum Protection Service has presented a proposal and said proposal has been attached.

Proposal five (5) additional armed guards for 7 hours. Total \$875

- 3) Health: Disposable face mask, hand sanitizer and paper towels.

Disposable Masks: 100 for \$20

Paper towels: 12 rolls for \$20

Hand sanitizer: 60 oz Equate for \$10

Total: \$50

Total Estimated Cost

Port-a-johns: \$ 430

Security: \$ 875

Health: \$ 50

Total: \$1,355
